Meet ISLA - our attendance mascot. Each week, the class with the best attendance gets to keep ISLA for the week...


96\%+ VERY GOOD

At this level, you give yourself the best chance of achieving your potential.
$96 \%$ equals 7.5 days absence in a year.

93 \%-95.9 \%

COULD BE BETTER

95\% means a half-day missed every 2 weeks.
In a year, that's 43 lessons to catch up on.
90.1\% - 92.9\% IMPROVEMENT REQUIRED

92\% equals 3 weeks of lost learning every year.
Between Y7 and YII, this means 15 weeks lost in total.

## 90\% and below

 PERSISTENTLY ABSENTAt $90 \%$, you have missed almost 100 lessons in a year:
Attendance at $90 \%$ each year means that by YII, you will have missed out on 6 months learning.

If you would like to know your child's \% attendance - please just ask. If you are struggling to get your child to school -we want to help!
